The Kent Showground will be hosting the Heritage Transport Show on **Saturday 1 April 2017** from 10.00 am – 4.00 pm. On display will be approximately 500 vehicles including motorbikes, cars, tractors, commercials and many more. Other attractions are detailed below.

Maidstone Exhibition Hall

This year the 2017 Heritage Transport Show will take place in the Maidstone Exhibition Hall and surrounding outdoor space. The 3000m² single span Maidstone Exhibition Hall allows us to use more undercover space for trade, vehicle displays and attractions.

South East Bus Festival

Once again we will be working with the South East Bus Festival. This part of the event is becoming a firm favourite, featuring a display of approximately 100 buses and bus related trade stands. Visitors and exhibitors can take advantage of as many free vintage bus rides around the Showground as they like. Returning Farmers Market

Kent Showground Rules and Regulations

Show Times

- **All exhibits must be in place by 9.30 am and cannot be moved until 4.00 pm.** If you would like your vehicle to be inside the John Hendry, you will need to be onsite at 8.30 am (after this time we cannot guarantee that you will be inside).
- There is no guarantee that cars will be allowed inside as this is on a first come first served basis.
- All cars must be in place in the building by 8.30am or they will be refused entry.
- The Kent Showground is open from 7.30 am to 6.00 pm on Saturday, 1 April.
- The Show will be open to the general public from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm.

Tickets

- All exhibits will be given the appropriate vehicle passes to gain access to the Showground.
- Each exhibit will be allocated with two entrance tickets to the Show.
- Additional visitor tickets can be purchased at the pre-Show rate of £7.00 per adult (£10.00 on the gate), under 14's free, pre Show rate only available until Friday 10 March 2017. Tickets can also be purchased from www.kentshowground.co.uk (January to March only) or on the Exhibitor Application Form.

Insurance

- All vehicles and working machines must be insured against third party risks including use for off road and/or display use. Documentation must be brought to the Heritage Transport Show and may be checked by the appropriate steward.

Vehicle Restrictions

- Exhibits will only be considered on this form if manufactured before 1990.
- Exhibits which date after 1990 will only be considered within the 'Classic of the Future' area. Please contact the Show Office for more information if your vehicle falls into this category.
- Kit cars will be accepted at the 2017 Heritage Transport Show. They will be allocated space outside. They will be exempt from paying the entry fee for 'Classic of the future'.
- Please note that we will also require a list of the cars attending from the club.

Movement of Vehicles

- The road traffic act applies to all places to which the public have access, therefore no unlicensed or under age driving is permitted.
- The speed limit on the Showground is 10 mph. This applies to ALL vehicles on the Showground. The one way system of the Showground must be observed at all times.
- Movement of all vehicles is restricted to travel to and from the ring or for permitted display purposes.
- If seatbelts are fitted on the vehicle they must be worn when travelling on the Showground.

General Regulations

- The placing of exhibits will be entirely at the discretion of the Society and their Stewards, although every endeavour will be made to meet any request made by an exhibitor.
- All persons must pay proper regard to the Stewards' instructions and should conduct themselves in a manner, which will not inconvenience other persons at the event.
- Please include a self-addressed A5 stamped envelope with your entry form.
