


ARDENNES 3.0

After a break of two years due to the Covid pandemic, we have started again to organise a new edition of the European Sliding Pillar Rally. It is now more than 20 years since we held the first edition of the rally on the continent, the first two meetings (in 2001 and 2003) took place in the Ardennes, with Houffalize as our base.

This year we decided to cross the Belgian Ardennes once again. Those who have been there before will certainly remember this beautiful region, for newcomers it will definitely be a pleasant surprise. The region is large enough to discover new roads and sights. If we were to resume certain routes from those first editions, it will surely be an enjoyable renewed acquaintance.

The home base for this 11th edition – from 2 to 5 June 2023 – will be the “R-Hotel” in Remouchamps, a sub-municipality of Aywaille. This

modern four-star hotel has its own restaurant and also equipped with a Fitness and Wellness Center, including an indoor swimming pool, which is available to the participants of the rally that weekend.

Known as the “Pearl of the Amblève”, the river that crosses the village, Sougné-Remouchamps is also known for its unique caves, which have attracted tourists since 1828. The contemporary visitor can discover much more than the travelers of the 19th century: spacious galleries, beautifully sculpted by nature, lead them to a room that was only discovered in 1912: “the Cathedral”, 40 meters high. The most charming moment of the visit, however, is the return by boat, on the river that runs through the lower level of the cave. The visitor can enjoy the longest subterranean boat trip in Belgium and, incidentally, also the longest in the world that is accessible to tourists.

Sougné-Remouchamps is also remembered among cycling enthusiasts for “La Redoute”, a hill in the Ardennes that is best known as a climb in the cycling classic Liège-Bastogne-Liège. The top of La Redoute is at an altitude of 292 meters. The track over the hill is 1650 meters long.

Professional cyclists have to climb a height difference of 161 meters, with steep parts and a slope of 22% with an average of 9.5%. It goes without saying that Philippe Gilbert, one of the best cyclists Belgium has known, who ended his active career this year, was born in Remouchamps and has climbed this hill a lot!

Remouchamps is located where the roads to Banneux, Spa, Coe and Aywaille intersect. However, for car enthusiasts, the Spa-Francorchamps circuit, less than half an hour away, will ring more bells.
