RULES AND REGULATIONS 2024

1. All entrants must be fully paid-up members of the Lancia Motor Club.
2. Entries must be received **by midnight on Wed July 17th, 2024**. Entries can be made:-
 - 2a. On the club website – go to www.lanciamc.co.uk, click “Meetings & Events”, scroll down to 21 July and click on “Concours”, or
 - 2b. Download a digital version of this form from the forum, use “Save As...” to give the form a new name and then email the saved form to concours@lanciamc.co.uk, or
 - 2c. Complete and return this form to the address at the top of the page overleaf.
3. All vehicles, except Competition Class entries, must be driven to the event and the organisers may check that their road fund licence and insurance is up to date. Competition Class entries may be trailed to the event but must be insured for third-party liability as a minimum (insurance against accidental damage is recommended). Non-UK entries may be asked to show equivalent documentation for their country of registration.
4. To the best of the organisers’ ability, all cars will be parked in groups with similar models of car irrespective of their Concours status. Entrants will therefore receive a green card on arrival at the event, to be displayed in the vehicle windscreen. The green card enables judges to identify cars entered in the Concours apart from those just parked for display. Entrants arriving on the day will need to request their green card on arrival. Without a visible card, the car will not be judged.
5. All cars must be in the show field by 11:30 on Sunday 21st July. Judging will commence at 12:00 and will be completed by 14:00.
6. The purpose of the Concours is to reward vehicles that are in the best condition whilst being closest to the original factory specification. Period accessories or factory options are permitted. The owner of a car that deviates from standard may choose to enter the Modificato Class, for which the judging will focus on condition and engineering integrity.
7. Cars will be judged on exterior and passenger compartment condition and specification. Class winners from the previous two Concours are only eligible to enter the Master Class. Master Class cars will additionally be judged on their boot space and engine bay.
8. Entrants in the Master Class and Competition Class are not eligible for any other class.
9. Cars which have had significant restoration completed since July 2022 can also enter the Best Restoration Class in addition to their model class.
10. The decision of the judges is final and not eligible for any appeal. Scoring sheets will be available after the conclusion of the awards ceremony for explanatory purposes only.
11. By entering the concours all entrants are deemed to have accepted and be bound by the Rules & Regulations of the Concours.
12. The Lancia Motor Club Limited does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to any vehicle entered in the Concours. Insurance of the vehicle is the responsibility of the owner/entrant.
